



## White Suffolk Breed Aims

<b>HEAD</b>	Hornless, free of wool, face white, long and slightly convex, muzzle moderately fine especially in ewes.
<b>EARS</b>	Large, not carried erect, good length, white and fine texture
<b>EYES</b>	Bright and full
<b>NECK</b>	Moderate to long and well set (rams stronger with a good crest)
<b>SHOULDERS</b>	Smooth. Shoulder blade should be slightly lower than the spine and sloping away to a smooth setting, without excessive movement when walking. Width of shoulders to be less than hindquarter.
<b>BACK</b>	Long, level and firm with a deep, firm, wide and well muscled loin.
<b>LEGS AND PASTERNS</b>	White and placed to give sheep correct balance with flat bone. Woolled to knees and hocks, with clean below with pasterns well set up straight. The forearm should be strong and thick with muscle. Hind legs well filled with muscle.
<b>FEET</b>	Compact.
<b>SKIN</b>	Pink in colour.
<b>FLESH</b>	Firm handling with strong muscle content.
<b>SCROTUM</b>	Good size, well hung, carrying two normal and well developed testicles.
<b>FLEECE</b>	Firm down type wool, dense and firm handling free from kemp medulated and coloured fibre.
