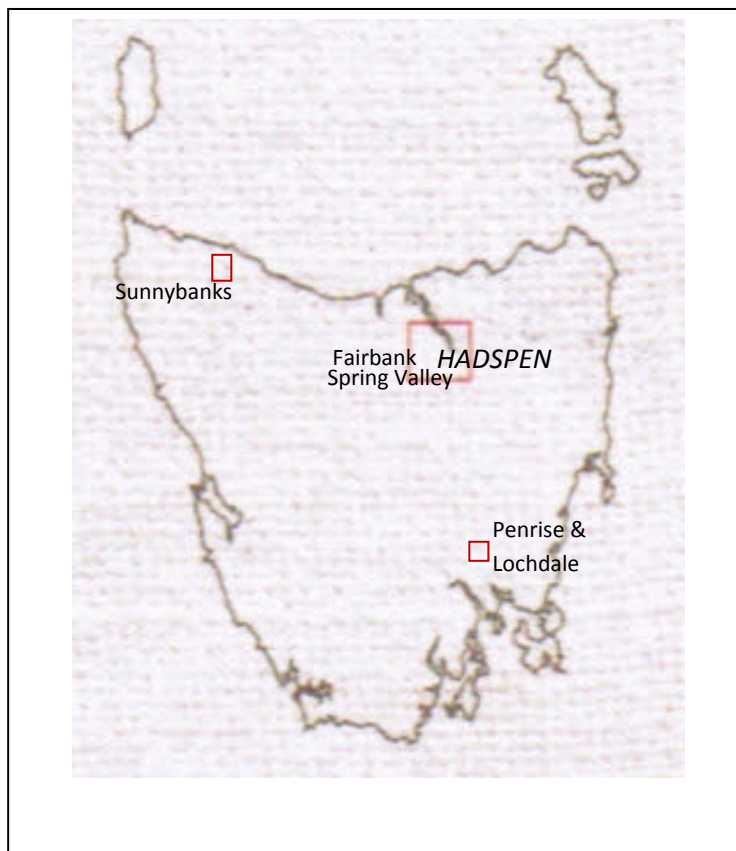

Our stud is open to visitors before or following the conference

Directions - From Hadspen head west on the Meander Valley Road for approximately 15km towards Hagley. At the Roundabout turn South onto Hagley Station Lane, "Fairbank" is 1.7km on the right. Total travel time from conference venue is approx 12-15mins.

Fairbank have been breeding prime lamb sires since 1903 and our operation has consistently involved stud breeding either being sheep or cattle since this time. Today the property is comprised of White Suffolks, Poll Dorsets and Southdown studs with a combined total of 560 stud ewes as well as poppy and cereal production. Our stud is registered flock number 20 and was founded in 1986 based on our own Poll Dorset ewes and Suffolk rams. We later sold the entire flock to Ian Turner's Renrut stud on Kangaroo Island in 1993. The stud was then re-founded in 1996. The stud is a regular supporter of the local show scene with an annual on property ram sale occurring in November each year, all studs are Lambplan recorded.

Our stud will be open on Saturday afternoon and Wednesday following the conference.

Directions - From Hadspen-head west on the Meander Valley Road & turn left towards Bracknell. On reaching Bracknell turn right at the 1st crossroads and follow that road out of town towards Liffey Falls. After approx 2.5 km from the town outskirts turn right into 'Spring Valley' (on an elbow turn where the road goes left). Travel time from conference venue is approx 20 mins.

Founded in 1985 as 'Valma', then changed to 'Keen & McLauchlan'. In 2005 we formed two studs by drafting alternate sheep. John & Kerry formed 'Leith' and Rob & Sally formed the Spring Valley stud. 'Spring Valley' is 1500ac where we run 500 White Suffolk stud ewes. Our annual flock ram on property sale is in November and we sell approx 200 flock rams per year. We sell stud rams at Adelaide Royal, as part of the Valma Poll Dorset stud sale at Tarcutta, NSW, and hopefully next year at Bendigo. We also run a further 600 commercial White Suffolk ewes with the ewe lamb portion sold as maternals. 70 Poll Hereford breeders and a small amount of cropping.
